The homeowners of a 1960 Arlington, VA, rambler wanted open space suitable for entertaining, so Architect Matthew Ossolinski designed and The Ley Group built a contemporary addition with sweeping curves, a distinctive roofline, and a second-floor deck shaded with cedar beams that were selected by hand. Each window is framed in bold black aluminum, and some are custom-colored amber glass to provide privacy without sacrificing appearances. A "three-season" room lies below the deck, and at night, the house seems to glow from within.
